



# Uniform CPA Examination Scholarship Application

**Submission deadline: September 30**

The Hawaii Society of CPAs (HSCPA) CPA Examination Scholarship is intended to cover the Uniform CPA Examination fee (up to \$1,000). Successful candidates must demonstrate achievement as well as financial need and meet the guidelines below.

## Application:

- Must be a Hawaii resident currently attending an accredited Hawaii college or university
- Current or final cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Not be reimbursed for exam fees by an employer
- Must be majoring, or concentrating, in accounting and have completed an intermediate accounting course
- Complete Personal Essay
- School transcript

## Eligibility (to redeem award):

- Candidate must be pre-approved to test by CPAES have a valid Notice to Schedule (NTS). A candidate will receive an NTS after he/she applies to take an examination and deemed eligible by the Hawaii Board of Public Accountancy (through CPAES).
- Agree to sit for at least one part within six months of the date on the application approval letter from CPAES
- Provide proof of payment
- Candidate will be reimbursed subject to receiving above information and upon completion of all four parts of the exam.

Note: Scholarships will be awarded to individuals on a one-time only basis, but can be applied for by both first-time and re-examination candidates.
